# Themes for member contributions

# Theme 1: Introduction to Franchising

*Encouraging women to consider franchising their businesses.*

We are seeking insightful articles, blogs, and expert advice to inspire and support women considering franchising their businesses. # How to **share** your content with us

## 1. **Blogs, articles & thought leadership**

Contribute to our campaigns by sharing your insights on franchising, business growth, industry trends, or success stories. We welcome contributions in the following formats:

- **Articles:** Well-researched, informative, or opinion pieces that provide value to the audience.
- **Blogs:** Personal stories, tips, or reflections. Keep it informative, engaging, and around 400 words.
- **Vlogs:** Engaging videos on a topic you're passionate about, from how-to tutorials to thought-provoking discussions. Ensure your video is clear, well-lit, and easy to understand. Length: Aim for 3-7 minutes, keep it engaging and to the point!

Submitting blogs and articles

- Email your finished article or blog to [info@ewif.org](mailto:info@ewif.org) with the subject line: "*Blog/Article Submission – [Your Topic]*".
- Include a brief bio: Let our readers know who you are! A few lines about you and your expertise are always appreciated.





### Submitting vlogs

- Upload your vlog to a platform like YouTube or Vimeo.
- Send us the link to your vlog at [info@ewif.org](mailto:info@ewif.org) with a brief description of what it covers. Use the subject line: *"Vlog Submission – [Your Topic]"*.
- Include a bio: Just like with articles and blogs, let our audience know who you are!
